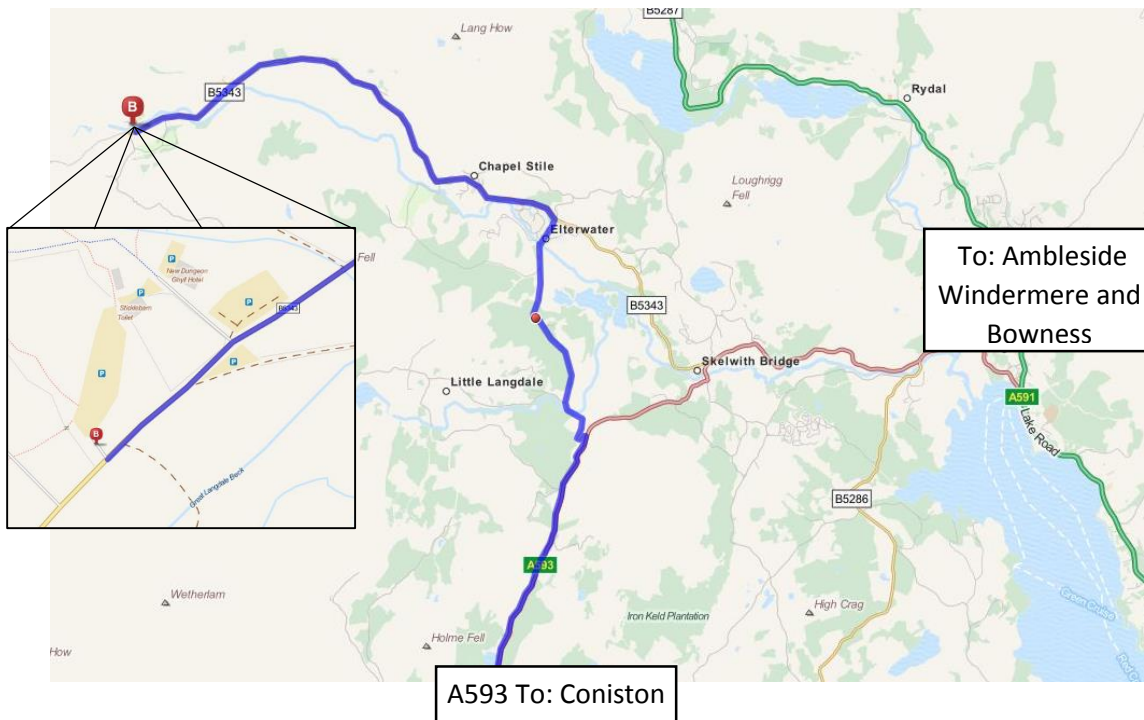


The Old Dungeon Ghyll pub from Coniston

Directions to the Old Dungeon Ghyll pub (LA22 9JY)



*From the South A590, Newby Bridge and Coniston

Turn off the A590 at Greenodd signposted Workington, Greenodd and Coniston and follow the A5092 for 2 miles, until right turn signposted Coniston A5084. After 6.1 miles turn right at the T-junction onto the A593 (to Coniston). Continue on this road in into and through Coniston. After approx 6 miles turn left at Skelwith Bridge towards Langdale along the B5343. Go along this road through Chapel Stile and continue for three miles (passing the National Trust campsite) until you come to the Old Dungeon Ghyll Hotel signposted on the right. Turn right following the hotel signs. The National Trust car park is next to the hotel car park so make sure you are in the correct area before parking up. The car park is a pay and display car park that will cost around £4.50 ½ day, £8 (in coins only) full day.

Toilets nearby? Public toilets adjoining park.

Local Amenities:

The Old Dungeon Ghyll pub next to car park, café and shop in Chapel Stile, 2.7 miles.
